## Introduction

This season, the Vitranc Cup is celebrating its 61<sup>st</sup> anniversary of the Alpine Skiing World Cup for men. As far back as 1961, the first competitors descended the ski slope from the top of Mt. Vitranc to the foothills along the upper course of the Sava Dolinka. The caravan of the World Cup in Alpine Skiing of the FIS International Ski Federation first stopped in Kranjska Gora in March 1968. Throughout all those years, its organization has been developing concurrently with the development of alpine skiing and competitions' safety requirements, we have been gathering experience and know-how, and today, the Vitranc Cup is one of the largest, best organized and one of the best attended traditional sport events in Slovenia and in central Europe. Most merit for that shall be attributed to the diligent, hard-working, and determined inhabitants of Kranjska Gora and its neighbouring villages who co-create this top skiing event by their volunteer work. That is why the Vitranc Cup will continue to be deeply anchored in the FIS calendar also in the future.

This year, the organizers will yet again try to organize an event that will, after the release of measures to curb the pandemic, once again be able to accommodate a few thousand people who love alpine skiing. With a lot of effort and adjustments, we will also enable a smooth and safe running of the competition for all athletes and accompanying teams, and we will also enable journalists and photographers from major media houses and agencies to cover the competitions. The accompanying program is also slowly returning with Gruba's Memorial.

Let's make sure that the Vitranc Cup events go beyond the borders of Slovenia and Europe. 3



## Covid-19 Rules and Regulations

During the Vitranc Cup, the accommodation facilities with competitors as well as the racecourse and the Arena will be part of a so-called Bubble or Snowflake.

### Snowflake

The Snowflake is divided into four, colour-coded individual zones, which are intended for different groups of competition participants.

### Red Zone

The Red Zone is intended for the competitors and their accompanying teams (coaches, service technicians), timekeepers, jury, FIS representatives and the medical service. It comprises the racecourse, a ski slope warming-up with all its accesses, Team Hospitality, service rooms, Timing House with the jury, doctor's room and an energy and communication room, as well as the accompanying parking lots. Access to the Red Zone is only possible with a negative PCR test and a filled-out FIS Covid Passport.

### Blue Zone

The Blue Zone is intended for the members of the organizing team and covers all areas where representatives of the organizer are needed for the smooth running of the event.

### Green Zone

The Green Zone is intended for the representatives of TV compound houses, which transmit the international TV signal, as well as those who have their own studios in the Arena and includes the area of TV compound and a space for live studios near the Finish Arena.

### Yellow Zone

The Yellow Zone is intended for media representatives and includes the Media Centre, commentators' booths, a space for the media next to the Finish Arena, as well as commentators' booths and accompanying parking lots.

### Entrance to Snowflake

In order to collect the accreditation and thus also to enter the Snowflake, **the fulfilment of the RVT conditions (recovered, vaccinated or tested) will not be checked.**

Please follow the current recommendations of the National Institute of Public Health (NIJZ) for preventing the spread of Covid-19 virus infections and use a **protective mask type FFP2** during your presence in the competition bubble in Podkoren.



## Accreditations

The Vitranc Cup OC will be accepting accreditation requests and applications exclusively through their official website <http://www.pokal-vitranc.com/mediji/akreditacije/>. We started accepting accreditation applications on February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022; and will be accepting them until March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022 until 24:00 hours (midnight). Thereafter, the accreditation will no longer be possible due to the high level of health security.

Accreditation can be collected at the Accreditation Office only after filling out the Covid questionnaire.

With accreditation, you will enter the Snowflake in Kranjska Gora and Podkoren. Wear it in a visible place.

All photographers with special access to the racecourse need to be familiar with the "FIS On-course Photographers' Rules" published on <http://www.pokal-vitranc.com/mediji/fotografiranje-na-progi/> which are attached to these Guidelines. All photographers also need to sign a special statement. Upon failure to observe the Rules and instructions, the organizer may withdraw the accreditation.

## Accreditation Office

Accreditation Office is located in the Oval part of the Ramada Resort (ex Larix Hotel) in Kranjska Gora.

## Media Centre

The Media Centre is located **next to the Finish Arena in Podkoren**. The 200m<sup>2</sup> premises for the media representatives provide excellent working conditions in the immediate vicinity of the competition thus enabling faster reporting. All necessary technology (free internet access) and equipment (photocopiers ...) will be made available for the smooth work of journalists and photographers. Due to the epidemiological situation, more than 50 workstations are available, whereat the FIS priority list of photographers and the reach of the contents of the agency or the media house will be taken into consideration.

Head of the Media Centre is Ms. Suzana Žbogar.

The Media Centre opening hours:

on Saturday, **March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022**, from **7:00** to **18:00**,

on Sunday, **March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022**, from **7:00** to **17:00**.

Media Centre can only be accessed with a valid accreditation.

'Telekom Slovenije' (national telecommunications provider) will provide broadband access in the Media Centre. For an exclusive telephone line, please arrange directly with the operator 'Telekom Slovenije' ([www.telekom.si](http://www.telekom.si)). Free wireless Internet access will also be provided in the Media Centre.

## Traffic Regime

A special traffic regime will be organized during the Vitranc Cup in Kranjska Gora and Podkoren. Parking spaces for all accredited journalists and photographers will be provided in the immediate vicinity of the racecourse. Circular transportation for journalists, the so-called Media Shuttle, will not operate this year.

## Accommodation

Due to the epidemiological situation and so as to ensure high safety conditions inside the Snowflake in Kranjska Gora and Podkoren, the Ramada Hotel & Suites has been booked for the media representatives.

## Meals and Refreshments

Meals for all accredited journalists and photographers will be provided in the Media Centre near the Finish Arena in Podkoren. A portion cold meal will be available at the Media Centre during competition days, i.e. on Saturday, March 12<sup>th</sup>, and Sunday, March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022.





## Press Conferences with the Winners

Press conferences with the winners of giant slalom races will be held via a live video link at the Podkoren Media Centre, approximately 10 to 15 minutes after each prize-giving ceremony in the Finish Arena.





## Media Rights

The holder of the global media rights for the 61<sup>st</sup> Vitranc Cup 2022 is Infront Sports & Media AG.

International television and radio companies, production companies and internet news companies need to obtain the prior approval of Infront Sports&Media AG for a press accreditation. Your request for press accreditation will be automatically sent to Infront Italy.

Without the consent of Infront, the Vitranc Cup OC cannot issue press accreditation to international television and radio companies and internet news companies. When requesting accreditation, online media journalists must agree and confirm that they will not record videos during their work at the Vitranc Cup.

Applications for accreditations are also automatically forwarded to RTV Slovenia for approval. Only after their approval will we be able to issue you the required accreditation.

In case of abuse, the press accreditation will be withdrawn, and the rights holder may also instigate claims for damages against journalists breaching the rules.

On Friday's meeting, the bib draw for the next day's giant slalom will also be carried out, and on Saturday's meeting for the Sunday's giant slalom.

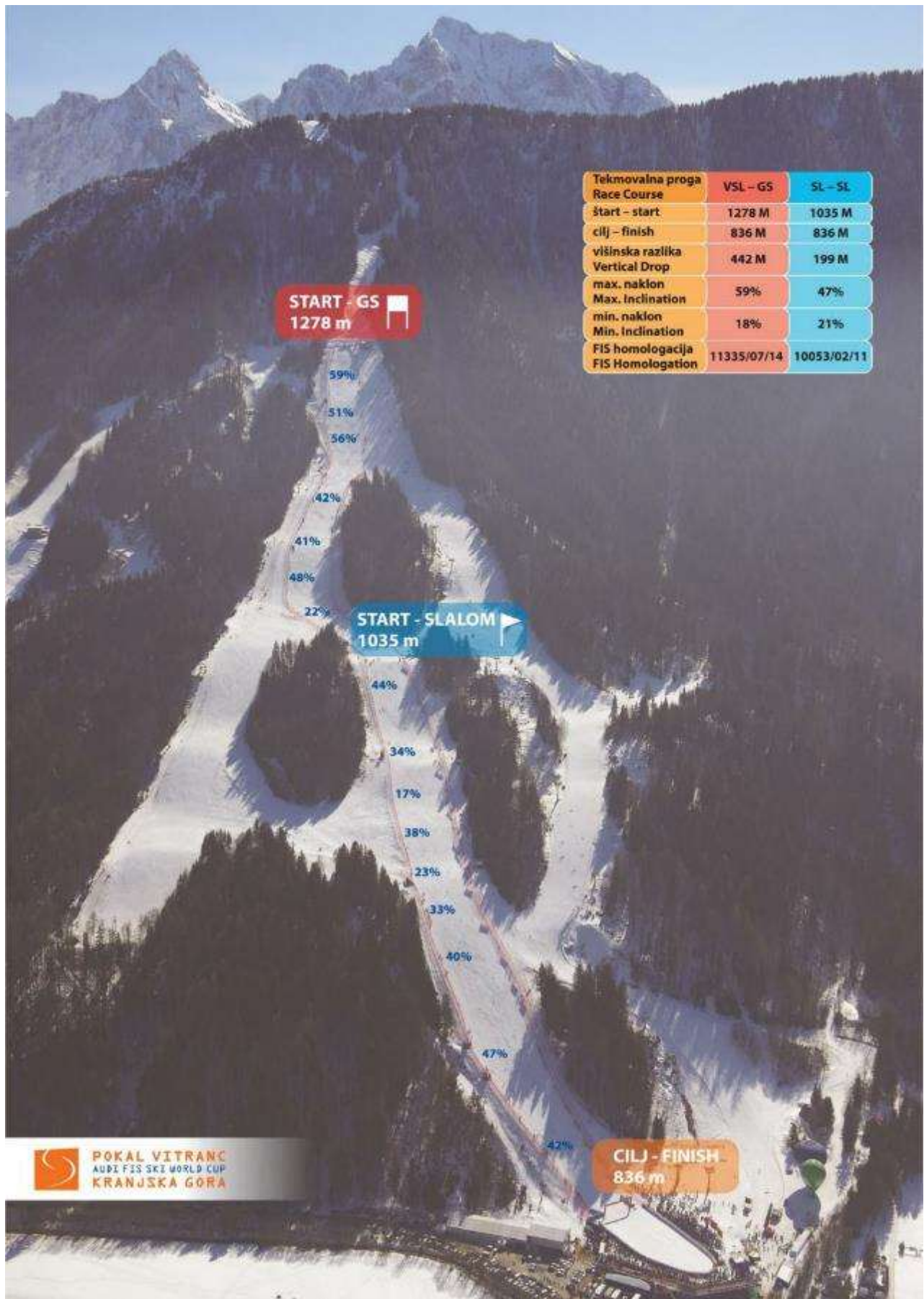

## **Pokal Vitranc #funfacts**

- Since 1961, the Vitranc Cup has been held on 4 different slopes in Kranjska Gora.
- The previous finish of the racecourse was located next to today's petrol station between Podkoren and Kranjska Gora; a part of the course (clearing) is still visible today.
- 84 World Cup competitions have been carried out within the Vitranc Cup (42 GSL, 41 SL, 1 ladies' SL), 11 European Cup competitions (3 GSL and 8 SL) and 20 FIS competitions at various levels.
- Kranjska Gora has carried out 5 replacement World Cup races for men, which had been cancelled in other World Cup locations.
- Kranjska Gora took over the organization of 10 'Golden Fox' competitions which were cancelled in Maribor due to the shortage of snow.
- The winners of the Vitranc Cup competitions come from 14 different countries.
- Most Vitranc Cup winners, 22, have so far come from Austria, which also has the most wins in both slalom and giant slalom.
- As many as 51 competitors from 14 different countries have won the Vitranc Cup up to now.
- Most wins have been achieved by Ted Ligety (USA) and Marcel Hirscher (AUT), namely 6. Ligety achieved all his wins in giant slalom.
- Most ranks among the best first three competitors were achieved Marcel Hirscher (AUT), namely 15.
- The worst winning percentage among the skiers who were placed among the three best skiers and actually took the first place, goes to Marcel Hirscher (AUT), who won six times, but was placed among the top three as many as 15 times.
- The longest period between the first and last win was recorded by Ivica Kostelić (CRO), who first won in 2003 and the second time, which was also the last time, in 2013.
- Standing on the Vitranc Cup winners' podium were also two brothers; Mario Matt (AUT) won in 2009 and 2011, while his younger brother Michael Matt (AUT) won the slalom in 2017.
- The smallest time difference between the winner and the second placed was in the giant slalom in 1970, where Mauro Bernardi (ITA) and Hans Enn (AUT) shared the first place.
- The smallest time difference ever recorded in slalom was in 1990, when Jonas Nilsson (SWE) beat Hubert Strolz (AUT) by 0.01 seconds.

- The largest time difference between the first and second ranked was recorded in the 1961 slalom, when Ernst Falsch (AUT) defeated Josef Stiegler (AUT) by 3.10 seconds.
- The largest time difference between the first and second in the giant slalom was 2.50 seconds in the same year - Josef Stiegler (AUT) beat Joseph Behr (GER).
- As many as 15 times was the difference between the first and second ranked higher than 1 second (4 times in slalom and 11 times in giant slalom).
- As many as 14 times, however, was the difference between the first and the second ranked less than one-tenth of a second (5 times in slalom, and 9 times in giant slalom).
- Most wins on the home snow were achieved by Bojan Križaj (SLO) – 4 in total, 3 in slalom and one in giant slalom.
- Bojan Križaj (SLO) also achieved the most placements on the winners' podium among all Slovenian skiers – 6 times.
- Jure Košir (SLO) was the last Slovenian skier to win the Vitranc Cup on home snow on January 6<sup>th</sup>, 1999.
- The last Slovenian skier to be standing on the podium on 'home snow' was Uroš Pavlovčič on the replacement giant slalom (cancelled race in Aspen), on December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2001.
- The tallest skier to win the Vitranc Cup is Ramon Zenhäusern with 200 cm.

## Appendix

### Rules and Regulations for On-course Photographers

Following are the rules and regulations that any photographer receiving an on-course photography accreditation/permission MUST follow relative to his/her conduct on the racecourse. These rules and regulations must be read, and the form must be signed, by which the undersigned certifies that he/she understood them and will comply with and respect them. A breach of any of the provisions will result in withdrawal of accreditation and authorization for access to the racecourse. The competition jury may also issue a sanction according to the FIS International Competition Rules (ICR), Article 223.

All armbands/bibs/authorizations for the on-course photographers will be issued upon the media registration in the Accreditation Office. The number of photographers allowed on-course is determined by the FIS Race Director. This number has been set at a maximum of 40 photographers but may be changed due to special circumstances. Please note that according to the Article 14.1 of the FIS World Cup Rules, "access to the racecourse is only possible when specially allowed by the Chief Race Director of FIS after clear agreement with the Organizers."

These rules and regulations have been set forth to help ensure safety for everyone on the racecourse and to provide the best working conditions for all parties concerned.

### On-course Photo Rules

Each photographer granted the access to the course MUST BE AN EXPERT SKIER AND HAVE CRAMPONS.

1. In order to gain access to the racecourse, photographers must display both their event media accreditation for this event and the on-course photographer armband/bib/permission needed to gain access to the racecourse. Please make sure that both are clearly visible to course security personnel.
2. All on-course photographers MUST be on their positions ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE START OF THE FIRST FORERUNNER. When accessing their photographing positions, photographers should slip down close to the security fence, NEVER BETWEEN THE GATES ON THE RACECOURSE.
3. Prior to the start of a competition, a member of the jury or a person officially charged with the task will make a final inspection slip to ensure that all photographers are in appropriate positions, which are safe also in the event of a potential fall of a competitor. If a jury member or a race official instructs a photographer to move from his/her initial position, the photographer must comply immediately.
4. All skis, backpacks and other equipment not utilized for photographing must be stored behind the safety fences, away from any potential drop out zone. Skis should be placed flat on the snow.
5. NO MONOPODS OR TRIPODS ARE ALLOWED ON-COURSE.
6. Photographers must stay in their selected positions until the end of the race. Moving to different positions is not allowed during the race. Photographers may leave their position only if specifically instructed to do so by the jury or race officials.
7. Photographers should be mindful of the sponsors' banners that are positioned along the course and must never stand in front of the banners so this would block their exposure to television.
8. Photographers MUST obey instructions received from members of the jury. Any requests to move or change their position MUST BE OBEYED IMMEDIATELY.

REFUSAL TO ADHERE TO THE ABOVE RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL RESULT IN THE CONFISCATION OF THE EVENT MEDIA ACCREDITATION AND ON-COURSE ARMBAND/BIB/PERMISSION, AS WELL AS POSSIBLE SANCTIONS BY the Vitranc Cup OC and FIS.



## Liability Statement

A FIS ad-hoc on-course photo accreditation to the 61<sup>st</sup> Vitranc Cup 2022 for persons who are not holders of a valid FIS Season Accreditation is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- the undersigned hereby expressly confirms that he/she is not under a sanction of ineligibility issued by FIS or by an entity the decisions of which are to be recognised by FIS in accordance with FIS Rules and in particular the FIS Anti-Doping Rules, as no valid accreditation can be issued in such case, respectively, any accreditation already granted at the time such sanction becomes effective will automatically become null and void.
- the undersigned confirms that he/she will attend the 61<sup>st</sup> Vitranc Cup 2022 in the specified function for which he/she is applying for accreditation and will not use the accreditation for any other purposes.
- the undersigned attests that he/she submits to and will strictly comply with the International Competition Rules (ICR) and their by-laws and will strictly follow all instructions of the organizers, the competition jury, race directors and representatives of the FIS.
- the undersigned acknowledges the fact that he/she is entering restricted areas including the racecourses, which is subject to specific additional permissions given by the FIS Chief Race Director, at his/her own and sole risks and responsibility and that, within the limits of applicable law, he/she fully excludes the FIS, the Vitranc Cup OC, their respective officers, employees and agents, as well as racers, trainers and other participants from any liability in case of any injury or damages he or she might have suffered.
- the undersigned further accepts that he/she may be held responsible for any damage or injury he/she is causing. In this respect, he/she also understands that, unless he/she is covered by the general civil liability insurance of the Vitranc Cup OC, as a result of his/her specific function either within the Organising Committee or within the scope of the ICR, he/she is not covered by such insurance and he/she is, therefore, obliged to have an appropriate civil liability insurance of his/her own. In case no such insurance has been concluded, he/she shall take over the entire liability for the damage caused.
- the undersigned undertakes to behave properly at all times and to abstain from any act or behaviour which would interfere with the organisation of the 60th Vitranc Cup 2021, including without limitation to the use of his/her accreditation for purposes which are in conflict with the legitimate activities authorised by the FIS and/or the Vitranc Cup OC (e.g. unauthorised commercial or media activities).

The undersigned acknowledges and accepts that failure to comply at any time with any of the above terms and conditions may lead to withdrawal of the FIS ad hoc on course photo accreditation and the permission for the access to the racecourse. (The Jury may sanction according to the ICR, Article 223.)

Any issue related to the application, grant, denial, withdrawal, validity or content of such a FIS ad hoc on course photo accreditation and permission to access the racecourse is governed by the FIS Rules and, subsidiarily, the Swiss law.

Without limitation to the jurisdiction of any body of competent jurisdiction in connection with the application of the FIS Rules to which the undersigned may be submitted, any dispute which is not to be adjudicated in application of specific procedures provided for by the FIS Rules, but which arises between such accredited person and the FIS and/or the organiser, including but not limited to issues linked with application for grant, denial, withdrawal, validity or content of the FIS ad hoc on course photo accreditation or claims for damages of either party against the other arising out of occurrences (acts or omissions) linked with the use of such accreditation shall be exclusively settled by arbitration before the Court of Arbitration for Sport ("CAS") in Lausanne in accordance with the CAS' rules then in effect.
